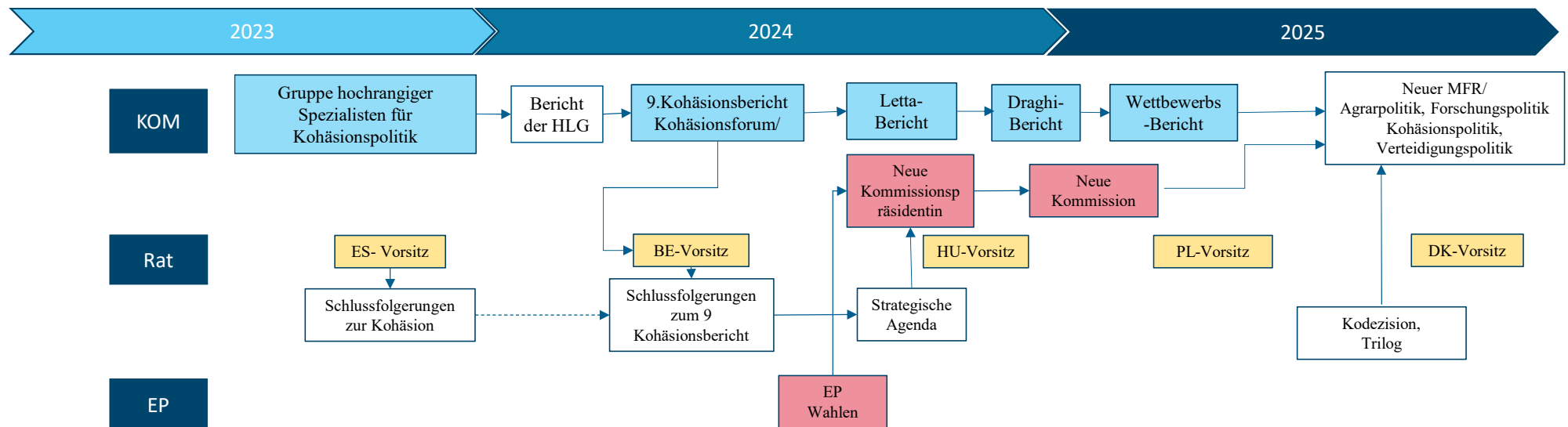

Territories and the maritime sector overlooked in the Draghi report[Home / Cohesion, Mar](#)

The long awaited “Draghi Report” commissioned by President of the European Commission to former European Central Bank (ECB) chief and Italy’s Prime Minister Mario Draghi, was unveiled last 4 of September. “The Future of European Competitiveness” outlines a macro analysis of the challenges for Europe to stay competitive in a rapidly changing global landscape and presents some bold actions to respond. However, while the report formally stresses the importance of cohesion and mentions the points raised by the Letta report on single market, it largely ignores rising territorial issues, as well as the potential of bottom-up, territorial competitiveness and innovation. There is also hardly any mention of the maritime sector disregarding the emerging strategies, its great growth potential and strategic geopolitical contributions.



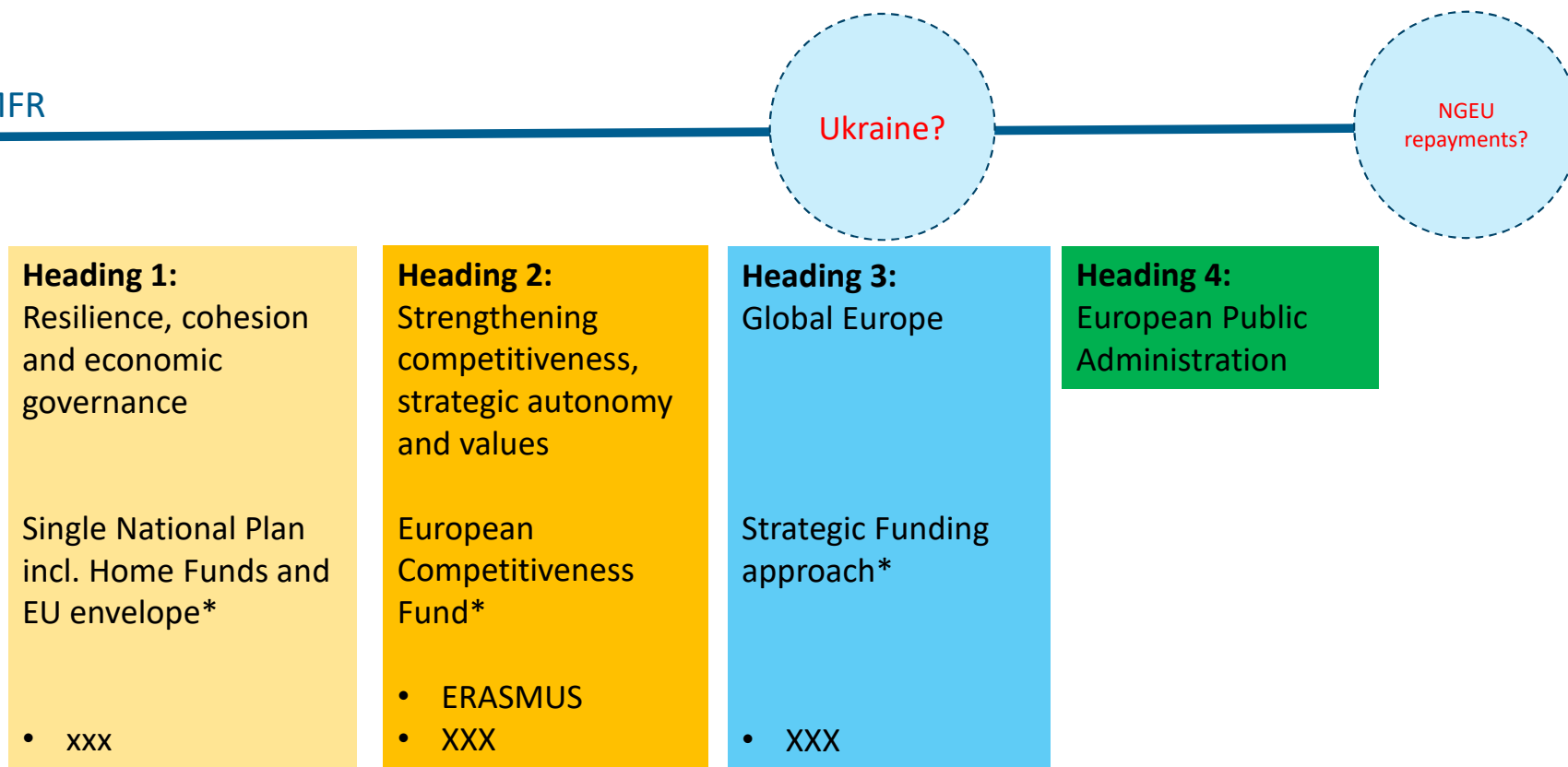

The CPMR has identified concerning elements in “The Future of European Competitiveness” Report that collide with CPMR’s vision for a Europe of Regions where Territories Matter. Despite listing some of the wording on the need to involve regions and the importance of cohesion, stressed by the Letta report and the political guidelines of the Commission President, the actual recommendations seem to point to a centralised approach with little regard to the spatial implications. The report does not recognise the need to increase decentralisation and autonomy of action at sub-national level alongside the priorities of “simplification” and “acceleration” of the EU decision-making process.

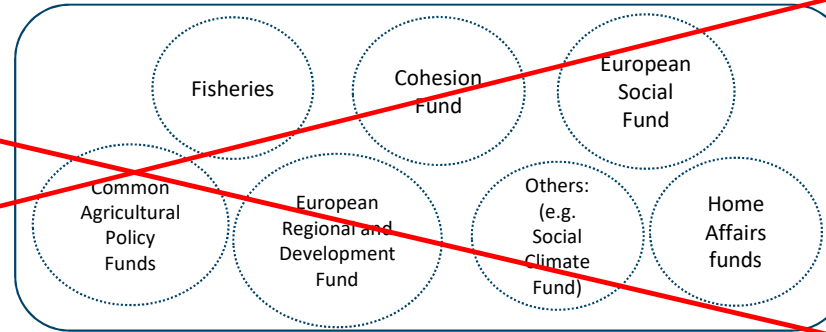

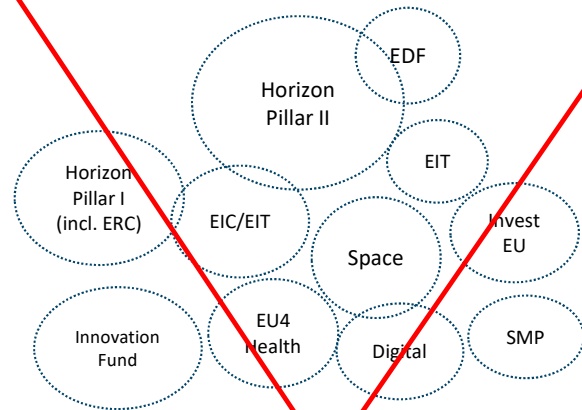

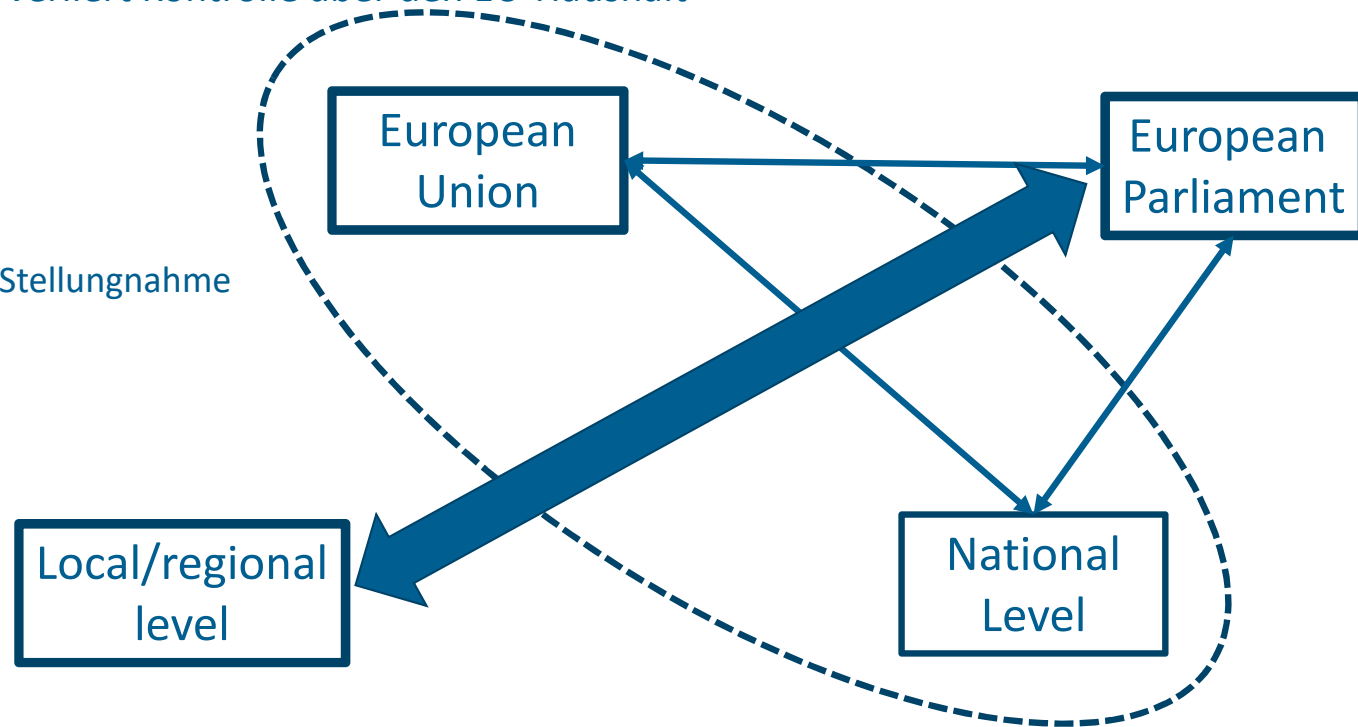
